Valhalla

To ensure that your stay at Valhalla is pleasurable for you and other guests, we would appreciate your compliance with the following guidelines.

ON ARRIVAL

- Please check the state of the house and report any untidiness to the booking officer.
- Dogs are not allowed inside. The exception is the covered courtyard at the front of the building.
- Members visiting Valhalla, but not staying overnight, are entitled to use the kitchen and toilet facilities.
- If sharing the house with others, please be considerate.

ON DEPARTURE

Before leaving, please check the following:

Check each bedroom Tidy and vacuum each room, lock windows and ensure curtains are left open.

Bathroom, Toilet and Laundry Areas Clean the hand basins, toilets, and showers. Leave the fridges turned on. Check the large freezer and leave on. Wash floors.

Kitchen Clear and wipe bench tops, wipe out fridge, which can be left on. If turned off, please leave the door open. Check coffee machine and teapots to ensure left empty. Wipe out microwave and wall oven, clean cook tops. Turn off all appliances at the wall. Wash floor.

Lounge, Dining Room and Hallway Tidy and vacuum room. Leave curtains open.

Rubbish Removal Take all rubbish with you. If you use official Rodney District Council bags then you can leave the bags on the corner of Pakiri Road and Goat Island Road where it will be collected on Tuesdays. Rubbish bags can be purchased at the Leigh Store, Warkworth or Matakana.

Doors Keep all bedroom doors open and unlocked but lock the three exterior doors. Secure both ranch sliders with the wood blocks in place. Shut and lock all windows.

Take all your personal belongings with you Vacate rooms by 5pm. Check the house and take all your belongings with you. Also, please sign the Visitors Book in the lounge.

... and the last one to leave should shut the gate.

HOW TO GET THERE



From Warkworth head towards Leigh. At Leigh turn left in to Pakiri Rd. Turn right into Goat Island Rd and immediate right into Cape Rodney Rd and go to the end before Te Kiri Marae. BEWARE – Just before Valhalla you will descend a steep, tar-sealed hill, cross a single-laned bridge and drive up a steep, gravel, private road. Continue through and the gates of Valhalla will appear on your right.

WHAT DO I BRING?

Your own sheets, pillows, blankets, toilet paper, tea towels, towels, food and beverages. Drawers are available in the kitchen for food storage. A fridge named after each room is available in the laundry along with an upright freezer with named shelves.

WHAT DO I FIND?

Valhalla is a seven bedroomed house with a communal kitchen, large dining area, lounge, three showers (One suitable for disabled members/guests) and three toilets. There are 18 acres of land which is newly planted in bush with plentiful parking on the eastern side of the house.
